1. APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr. R. Prince.

2. ELECTION OF CHAIR 2011/12

It was **RESOLVED:** *that Cllr P M Williams be re-elected Chairman of the Council for the municipal year 2011/2012.*

3. CHAIR'S ADDRESS

The Chair reported on items addressed during her year of office, with particular reference to the continued success of the Community Advice Service.

Donations amounting to £29,570 had been distributed to 23 organisations. The Council considered 54 planning applications throughout the year.

The Council had been successful in receiving a £4000 Tidy Towns Grant which had been supplemented by Community Council funding to create a community garden at Manley Road. The Council also paid for the erection of fencing on the roundabout at Sutton Drive following a request from the Residents Association and the Police and had funded some gardening work to the roundabouts at Larch Grove, Kingsley Circle and Deva Way and hedge cutting at Gwenfro. A financial contribution was again made to Wrexham CBC towards the costs associated with both Kingsley Circle and Pentre Gwyn Community Centre. The Community Council funded fencing around the perimeter of the football pitch at Whitegate Road. A programme of enhancing street lighting had been undertaken although lengthy delays were experienced in the completion of the work.

The Chair also referred to the liaison with North Wales Police over the proposal to withdraw the passive police dog from service. The Council also made strong representations to the Boundaries Commission over their proposal to amalgamate the Wynnstay Ward with Rhosnesni.

4. ELECTION OF VICE-CHAIRMAN
