1. APOLOGIES

There were no apologies for absence

2. ELECTION OF CHAIR 2009/10

Two nominations were received for the position of Chair for the ensuing year.

RESOLVED: that Cllr P M Williams be re-elected Chairman of the Council for the municipal year 2009/2010.

3. CHAIR'S ADDRESS

The Chair reported on items addressed during her year of office, with particular reference to the continued success of the Community Advice Service. Donations amounting to £35132 had been distributed to 24 organisations and financial support given to the provision of the police dog. £16,000 had been spent on street lighting throughout the community and £11,000 for a new youth shelter at Smithfield. The Council had been successful in receiving a £15,000 Tidy Towns grant (used for a River Gwenfro improvement scheme) and had part funded refurbishment works at the Whitegate play area. A financial contribution was made to Wrexham CBC towards the costs associated with both Kingsley Circle and Pentre Gwyn Community Centre. 105 planning applications had been considered – an increase on previous years largely due to the Eagles Meadow development.
